Friday Poker Draw

The 2025 Prescott Vette Sette Car Show Committee has come up with some interesting options for the day before the car show. Instead of the traditional “Poker Run”, we are featuring a “Poker Draw”, along with a choice of activities for a fun day.

Should you choose to participate in this Friday fun, (\$10 per car), you may pick one of four options, each of which will be led by or accompanied by a PVS Club Member.

During **Thursday afternoon/evening check-in**, you will receive your “Poker Draw” Scorecard (and have the opportunity to buy a second scorecard for an additional \$10.) At that time, you will draw five cards for your ‘poker hand’. You will also receive instructions on the starting time and location for your selected activity.

Cash prizes for the best and worst poker hands will be awarded at Saturday’s Trophy Ceremony.

Friday “Poker Draw” Options:

- **2 Hour Scenic Loop:** Led by a PVS member, drive a local loop that includes a great stretch of **twisties**, some **55 mph ‘sweepers’**, with just a dash of straight highway. This option is the most scenic way to see the beautiful areas that surround Prescott.
- **Breakfast in Jerome:** Jerome is a funky mining town featuring a **delightful drive** (with some twisties) **and interesting tourist shops**. This drive will also be led by a local PVS member, allowing both you and your passenger to enjoy the sights. **FULL**
- **Nine holes of golf:** Join a few PVS club members and play 9 holes of golf, with each person having one club (of their choice). This option has an additional cost of \$36/player, which includes a shared cart.
- **Easy Trail Hike: Goldwater Lake or Watson Lake.** Both hikes are along water, are beautiful, and absolutely conflict with the notion of what you think Arizona looks like. There is an additional \$3/Corvette fee to enter the park.

Lunch (optional): All the above activities will include instructions to direct you to the Park Plaza Deli ParkPlazaLiquor.com or Frank’s Mexican restaurant, both in the same area.

Car Wash (optional): Also at the Park Plaza lunch location, there will be reserved spaces in the lunch-time parking lot that have hoses, buckets, car wash soap, and a vacuum cleaner or two. Bring whatever you use to scrub and dry your car (towels, microfiber, chamois, etc.)
