2024 E-Ray Corvette Announced Jan 17th 2023

- E-Ray Specifications
 - 2 Front wheel mounted electric motors (160 HP)
 - E-Ray has All Wheel Drive (adept in snow, rain)
 - Hybrid....not all Electric
 - Battery recharged by “Regenerative Braking”, not plugged in
 - Wider fenders, quarter panels and fascias than C8 Base
 - \$103K to \$114K price range – orders taken late 2023



How does the E-Ray Compare to the 2024 C8 – Z06?

1/4 Mile	10.5 Sec.	10.8 Sec.
Engine	LT2 6.2 Liter	LT6 5.5 Liter
Base Price	\$103 K	\$105K
