# DRIVEOUTS

Hello from your 2026 Driveout Coordinator – John Garley.

Plans for the JANUARY DRIVEOUT were changed at the last minute, so we'll reschedule for FEBRUARY, sorry about that. At this time, the best I can offer for a January drive is to talk among yourselves and determine who wants to run down to Scottsdale for the Barrett Jackson Auction. Weekday dates are January 19 to 23. It's a much more elaborate event than the one we saw in October.

**FEBRUARY DRIVEOUT** (see the announcement) is Corvettes & Coffee in Carefree. It's a casual display of about 75 Corvettes with coffee and doughnuts provided. The road between Carefree and The Cove restaurant has great scenery that is worth the drive all by itself. After leaving Corvettes & Coffee, we arrive at The Cove about 10:00. The only breakfast item on the lunch/casual menu scrambled eggs & bacon burrito (very good). The bonus is the outdoor patio seating along Bartlett Lake, which is so pleasant that you'll beg for slow service.

Hey all you early birds, let's get out of bed early to enjoy **Corvettes & Coffee in Carefree**, with a guest appearance by our 2025½ President - David Eicher. It will be good to see him again.


**Sunday February 1**, depart the Maverik gas station (Fain & Hwy 69) at **6:30**. We can expect an easy drive to Carefree at that time of morning.

**Corvettes & Coffee directions:** AZ 69 to I-17, to the Carefree/AZ 74 Highway exit. Turn left (east) onto W Carefree Highway for 12 miles. Turn left onto Tom Darlington Drive for 1 ½ miles. There will be a boatload of Corvettes in the Bashas parking lot on your right. It gets crowded so we'd like to be there by 8:00am.

The car show is over at 9:30ish. At your option, return the way you arrived, or let's have lunch at **The Cove** overlooking Bartlett Lake.

**Lunch directions:** Turn right on Tom Darlington Drive, right on E Cave Creek Road for 6 ½ miles. Turn right onto Bartlett Dam Road for 13 ½ scenic miles. The Cove is a well-located (marina) restaurant serving \$25 burgers or a \$17 breakfast burrito – just saying.
